

Membership Information

Criteria for Membership: The Membership of this Club shall be open to any person, regardless of race, creed, color, religion, sex, national origin, age or disability; provided, however, that each member must:

- Pay the yearly membership dues set forth in Club documents:
- Abide by the by-laws, safety codes, practices and procedures of TROSPER ARCHERY CLUB;
- Be willing, at all times, to conduct himself or herself in a manner becoming a sportsperson and an archer: and
- Be willing to support, to the best of his ability, the objectives, functions and activities of TROPSEER ARCHERY CLUB.

Privileges, Dues and Responsibilities of Membership

Privileges of Membership:

Privileges of Individual, Family, and Lifetime memberships include, but are not necessarily limited to: Voting privileges (ages 16 and above); reduced fees for club tournaments, daily shooting fees and league fees; newsletter; a quiver tag; access to the outdoor range, bow press, bow scales and paper tuner.

Dues:

Annual memberships dues described in club documents are based on the calendar year January 1 through December 31.

Responsibilities of Working Membership:

Work Party Hours for Working Individual and Family memberships: All members, age 16 years and above, must complete a minimum of sixteen (16) hours of work parties per calendar year. Work party hours must be verified and then recorded by the Club Secretary.

Each member shall be responsible for filing out the having a verified a “work party verification” form to ensure proper credit for work hours performed. Work party hours will be credited hour for hour.
